

# Story Elements

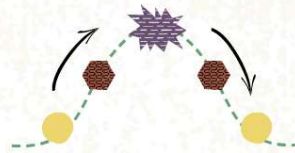
Writing a story involves knowing its important elements and organizing them in a way that is interesting and sensible to the readers. Use the prompts below to plan and organize your own story on the next page.

## SETTING



When and where does the story happen? How does the location and time shape the plot development?

## PLOT



What happens in the story?  
How are the events related from one another? What is the beginning, middle and ending part of the story?

## CHARACTER



Who are involved and how are they portrayed in the story? How do the characters grow and change in the story?

## POINT OF VIEW



Who is telling the story? What other point of view could this story be told with?

## THEME



What is the message that you want to convey to your readers? What is the lesson or idea in the story that is similar to real life?

## CONFLICT



What is the problem faced by the characters in the story? How is the conflict revealed in the story?
